




INFORMATION-WISE - PROJECT UPDATE -

WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?



Today's immense load information, asks students to acquire and apply a broad set of competences (e.g. critical thinking, metacognitive skills, problem-solving, and digital skills) to steer their way through the "information jungle".

Research from the Library and EDLAB reviewed developments in information literacy and yield important recommendations for information literacy education at UM.

Existing information literacy teaching approaches at UM face the challenge to equip students with highly relevant information and digital literacy skills.

3. Piloting and constructively aligning the programme's modules in different faculty courses
