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To what extent do certain factors predict whether a UM student feels the responsibility to help someone in need?

Factors: age, sex, family relations and religious activity.

Negative freedom: “do or be what is able to do or be, without interference from other persons” (Berlin, 1969, p.120).

CONCLUSION

- Generally: Students more likely to help than not help.
- Female student: More likely to help strangers and elderly people.
- Female students attending more religious gatherings: More likely to help the elderly.
- Saving stranger: Very likely to help elderly.
- Saving relative not predicting if student would save a stranger.

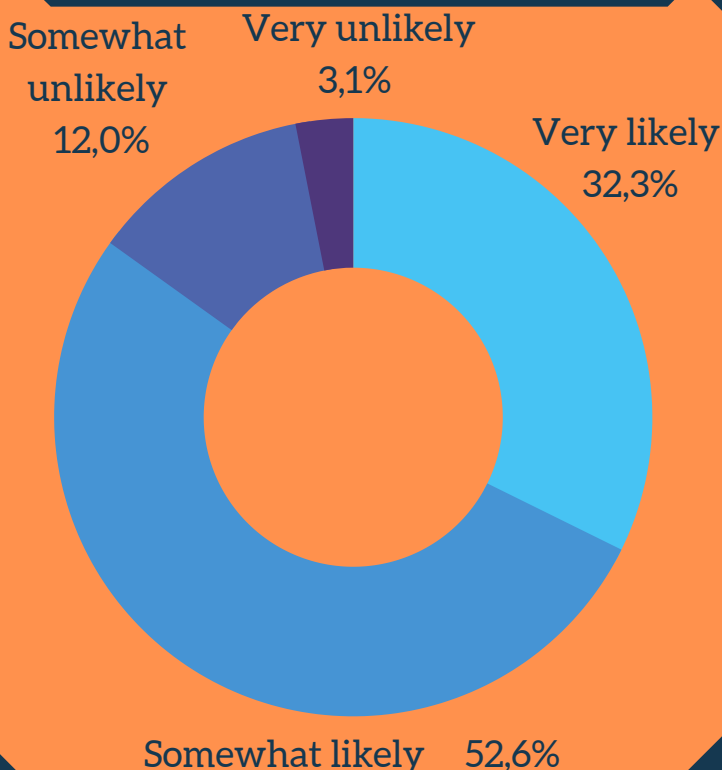


Fig.2. Relative falls in Maas
