

Why does uptake

Maps show the uptake of childcare spots in Germany for two different age groups. From Karten zur Statistik der Kindertagesbetreuung [Maps on childcare statistics] by the Federal Statistical Office of Germany.

The collection of data from academic and government sources led to the identification of relevant factors:

PERCEPTION OF QUALITY

SHORTAGE

MIGRANT WOMEN'S LABOUR MARKET PARTICIPATION

ACCESSIBILITY

DISCRIMINATION

More research will be necessary in the future due to limitations in the methodology
